Thanks for joining our worshipping community as we celebrate our Eucharistic Liturgy for the 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time. Your presence and prayerful participation enrich all gathered with us. May the words of Sacred Scripture enlighten your mind. May the Bread of Life nurture your faith.

Negative people can wear you out! The grumbler, the complainer can dampen your spirit. Moses and Aaron, along with the Lord, experience the grumbling of the Israelites in today's First Reading from the Book of Exodus. The Israelites grumbled against Moses and Aaron for leading them into the desert "to make the whole community die of famine." Hearing the grumbling of the Israelites, the Lord provides manna in order that "you shall have your fill of bread."

Rather than grumbling about the Ephesians, in today's Letter, St. Paul recognizes that they have already learned Christ. Paul encourages the Ephesians to put aside their Gentile ways. "Put away the old self of your former way of life," says Paul. They are to put on Christ, their new self, rooted "in righteousness and holiness of truth." Paul takes a positive approach acknowledging the Ephesians have been schooled in Christ and are to live what they have learned.

We, too, have "learned Christ!" We, too, know "righteousness and holiness of truth." Paul would encourage us to live out what we have learned, to be guided by God's way.

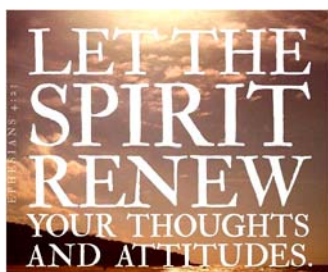

**A LITTLE ABOUT**



We are a Franciscan, Eucharistic community called to minister with the poor and homeless of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Formed in the spirit of the Gospel and inspired by the life and compassion of SS. Francis and Clare of Assisi, we try to meet the immediate daily needs of the people we serve with food, clothing and hospitality. Furthermore, we empower persons to break the cycle of homelessness and poverty and address structural injustices. We seek to build relationships with those that we serve by respecting their human dignity and by helping them to restore hope in their lives, and by living simply among them.

The Inn has been serving meals to the neediest individuals and families in Philadelphia since 1979. We opened our doors in December of 1979 and have served a meal every day since then. A breakfast of hot or cold cereal or pastries is served three days a week, while we serve a sit-down meal in our dining room every day. We now serve over 350 meals a day with dignity and respect. Our meal is unique because we serve our meals restaurant-style; our guests don't walk through a line to get their food, our compassionate volunteers serve them at their tables. We rely on the generosity of local grocery stores and businesses as well as churches and individuals to donate food so we can serve our daily meals. Volunteers come daily to help cook, serve and clean. With the help and support of volunteers and benefactors we are able to serve our guests every day with a warm, nourishing meal in a caring and respectful setting.

In addition to the dine-in meals, we also provide food baskets for families and homebound seniors monthly. A mixture of fresh and non-perishable foods supply regular sustenance to those unable to come to our meals. Mail services, phone usage, and many intangible resources also support our guests.
